FAIRBANKS — Veteran researcher Brad Griffith has been named leader of the Alaska Cooperative Fish and Wildlife Research Unit.

The unit is part of a nationwide cooperative program within the U.S. Geological Survey and Department of the Interior to promote research and graduate student training in ecology and management of fish and wildlife.


