The 2017 Global Change Student Research Grant Competition RFP is now available at [www.cgc.uaf.edu](http://www.cgc.uaf.edu), and in hardcopy from the Graduate School (202 Eielson) or URSA (301 Bunnell). Graduate students may submit proposals for up to \$10,000 for one year, while undergraduates are eligible for up to \$7,500. Students should review the RFP carefully before preparing a proposal. Among the changes this year is that students need to work with their department-level proposal coordinators to prepare their budget.
