This program celebrates the unique natural resources and cultural heritage shared by Russia and the United States in the region known as Beringia. From the Kolyma River in the west to Alaska's border with the Yukon in the east, Beringia includes the people, the land, and the water that connected the continents of North America and Asia during the Pleistocene ice ages. The area provides unparalleled opportunities to study both earth and human history. The overall purpose of the Shared Beringian Heritage Program is to advance local, national, and international understanding and preservation of the region's resources and to sustain the cultural vitality of its indigenous people.
