Eligible candidates must meet the following criteria:

- New or continuing UAF graduate students registered for ≥ 6 credit hrs/semester
- Good academic standing (≥ 3.0 GPA, current Graduate Study Plan and Annual Report)
- Must devote full time to research during the period of the award
- Major advisor must be an IAB faculty member
- Previous award recipients must have provided the required report on time
- All required safety training must be completed
